

Design and Construction H 1532

BACKGROUND: *The free-floating subdivisions **-Design and construction**; **-Design**; **-Designs and plans** are used under certain types of topical headings. This instruction sheet provides guidelines for assigning these subdivisions.*

1. Structures, machines, equipment. Use the free-floating subdivision **-Design and construction** under types of structures, machines, equipment, etc., for works on their engineering and/or construction, for example, **Automobiles-Design and construction**; **Cattle-Housing-Design and construction**.

2. Examinations. Use the free-floating subdivision **-Design and construction** under **Examinations** and under headings for types of tests and individual examinations for works on methods of designing and constructing tests, for example, **Multiple choice examinations-Design and construction**; **Graduate Record Examination-Design and construction**.

3. Other topics. Use the free-floating subdivision **-Design** under other topics where the use of **-Design and construction** would not be appropriate, for example, **Gardens-Design**; **Quilts-Design**.

Do not use the free-floating subdivision if a phrase heading has been established for the concept, for example, **Costume design**; **Magazine design**. Assign the phrase heading instead.

4. Designs and plans. Use the free-floating form subdivision **-Designs and plans** under architectural and landscape headings for works containing architectural drawings, for example, **Church architecture-Designs and plans**; **Landscape architecture-Designs and plans**.
