

**ALCTS/ALISE Task Force for Preparing Cataloging and Metadata Educators and Trainers (Action Item 5.1)
Quarterly Report
April, 2004**

The ALCTS/ALISE Task Force for Preparing Cataloging and Metadata Educators and Trainers (MetaCat TF) was constituted in April 2003 to carry out the recommendations of the ALCTS/ALISE Task Force on LIS Education (Action Item 5.1).

These include:

- Publicize the model for cataloging and metadata education
- Provide and publicize a “Metadata Basics” information package on the Web
- Publicize, provide and maintain a listserv for communications among LIS educators and continuing education specialists
- Publicize, provide and maintain a Web clearinghouse for cataloging and metadata educators and continuing education specialists
- Hold a conference to prepare educators and trainers to teach metadata and cataloging
- Assess results and produce a final report and recommendations

Status

The Task Force presented a full-day program at ALA Midwinter, San Diego, on January 9, *Preparing 21st Century Cataloging and Metadata Professionals: A Workshop for Educators and Trainers*. Approximately 80 attendees heard 7 presenters and engaged in discussions about the future of cataloging education and how we teach metadata skills needed for the future. A Web site was set up at the University of Washington Information School with materials for attendees to download both prior and subsequent to the workshop. ALCTS provided invaluable logistical support, handling registrations, all site arrangements, and staffing at the event. OCLC’s funding allowed for a minimal registration fee.

A listserv has been established, hosted by the Cataloging Distribution Service at the Library of Congress: EDUCAT@loc.gov. All attendees and presenters at the Midwinter workshop have been subscribed to continue their discussions, and eventually the list will be openly promoted to anyone interested in the challenges of teaching skills to organize electronic resources.

Consultants have been invited to work on the creation of the Metadata Basics package and the design and content of a Web clearinghouse. The names will be announced once the contracts have been finalized with the Library of Congress, which is funding these activities.

Next Steps

There are discussions underway with the task force addressing Action Item 5.3 to collaborate on the location and design of the Web clearinghouse. It will be important to find a suitable host site for the long-term viability of these projects.
