SPECIAL LIBRARY OF CONGRESS TOURS FOR ALCTS MEMBERS

On Friday, June 22, and Monday, June 25, the Library of  
Congress Acquisitions and Bibliographic Access Directorate will  
offer special tours for members of ALCTS. The tours begin with a  
30-minute walkthrough of the LC technical processing areas and  
conclude with in-depth discussions of topics of special interest to  
acquisitions and cataloging librarians.

After the focus discussion on both Friday and Monday, the LC  
Collections Access, Loan, and Management Division invites  
participants to view the collections control room and stacks in the  
Thomas Jefferson Building. On Friday only, participants will  
finish in the Jefferson Building in time for the open houses in the  
special collections reading rooms (from 2:00-4:00) and the Main  
Reading Room (from 5:00 to 7:00). This is a rare opportunity to  
see an acquisitions-to-access processing operation, tailored to
