

Directions to BIBCO OpCo Meeting

The meeting rooms, the Mumford Room and Dining Room A, are on the sixth floor of the Madison Building, at 101 Independence Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. The closest Metro stops are Capitol South (Blue and Orange Lines), immediately at the rear of the Madison Building, and Union Station (Red Line), approximately four blocks away.

The Library of Congress buildings are ***closed to the public before 8:30 A.M.*** After 8:30 A.M., the Madison Building is open to the public via the front entrance facing Independence Avenue or the entrance closest to the Capitol South Metro.

After entering the Madison Building, proceed through the airport-style metal detector and x-ray machine for luggage. Take the elevators to the 6th floor and use the map below to locate the appropriate meeting space.

The Mumford Room is located in the central core of the Madison Building, and Dining Room A is located to the West of the cafeteria in the yellow core of the Madison Building and adjacent to the Montpelier Room (a buffet style dining room).
