

- There is only one name to use as the basis of the preferred name
- Note the subfield coding of the 370 (\$e = Place of residence/headquarters)
- The 374 attributes were taken directly from the resource. It would have been fine to modify what appeared there, for example:
374 Cultural historian
- Everything is justified in the one 670 field


Comments:

- There is only one name to use as the basis of the preferred name
- The 372 and 374 attributes were taken directly from the resource
- If you prefer to use controlled vocabulary for the 372 field, this is a possibility:

372 Design \$a Interior architecture \$a Building \$2 lch

- Everything except the gender is justified in the one 670 field – gender does not need to be justified explicitly – we know that this is a female creator from the resource (“she writes ...”)
- Although you may want to record the periodical “onoffice magazine” as an attribute, it cannot be given in a 373 field (Associated group), since the Field Definition and Scope statement in the MARC 21 Authority Format reads:

“Scope Information about a group, institution, association, etc., that is associated with the entity in the [1XX](#). This can also be a group with which a person is or has been affiliated, including dates of affiliation.”



p. 4 of cover:



Comments:

- The preferred name is taken from the title page (RDA 2.2.2.2)
- The 372 Field of Activity attributes were taken directly from the resource and justified using \$v
- The 373 Associated Group attribute was taken directly from the resource and justified using \$v
- The 378 Fuller Form is justified in the 670
- The 375 Gender field does not need justification – it is in the one 670 field – gender does not need to be justified explicitly – we know that this is a female creator from the resource (“she also holds the license ...”)
- The variant forms of names (4xx’s) are not Core and are up to cataloger’s judgment



p. 4 of cover:


Albert A. Bell, Jr. was born in South Carolina in 1945 but for over thirty years has lived in Michigan ... his wife is a psychologist and he has four adult children and a grandson. He began writing in high school and sold his first magazine article in 1972. His first novel, *Daughter of Lazarus*, was published in 1988. Since the late 1990s he has had eight books published. The second novel in the series about Pliny the Younger, *The Blood of Caesar*, was named one of the 5 Best Mysteries of 2008 by *Library Journal*. *The Secret of the Lonely Grave* won the Evelyn Thurman Young Readers' Award in 2008. Mysteries are his favorite type of reading (and writing), but he also enjoys baseball and college basketball, and anything that has to do with ancient Rome.

Comments:

- Jr. is part of the preferred name – there is no conflict with another Albert A. Bell (RDA 9.2.2.9.5)
- The 370 Associated Place attributes were taken directly from the resource and justified using \$v. South Carolina as a place of birth is also explicitly justified in the 670
- The first 372 Field of Activity attributes are interesting—is this suggesting that the person plays or played baseball and college basketball? The resource says these are interests only.



About the Author:

Vicki Delany is one of Canada's most prolific crime writers.

Having taken early retirement from her job as a systems analyst in the high-pressure financial world, Vicki is settling down to the rural life in bucolic, Prince Edward County, Ontario where she rarely wears a watch.

Born in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Vicki was raised mostly in Ontario. As a young woman, fresh from quitting Carleton University in a huff in the middle of her final year, she travelled to South Africa where she promptly met a man, married him, and produced three daughters. Eleven years later, Vicki returned to Canada. Of her experiences in Africa she will only say that it gave her insight into to the politics of power and oppression that few Canadians get to experience.

Vicki majored in modern history at Carleton University, her interest more in the lives of ordinary women and men and the circumstances of their times than 'big men' and their wars. Comments:

- The 371 Address attribute is interesting. This is an Internet address, not an E-mail address, but it is allowed in the Field Definition and Scope statement in the MARC 21 Authority Format:

“For a person: the address of a person's place of residence, business, or employer and/or an e-mail or Internet address.”

- Note the 372 Field of Activity attributes – one uses LCSH controlled vocabulary, the other shows terms taken from the resource. Either 372 is fine
