**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION
TO COMMENCE HEARING ON ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED DATE**

On August 21, 2014, the Copyright Royalty Judges (“Judges”) modified the hearing schedule in the captioned matter from one that the Judges ordered on March 7, 2014. *Order Regarding Hearing Schedule*. In the August 21, 2014 order, the Judges ordered that the hearing would commence on September 8, 2014 (rather than September 2, 2014, as was specified in the March 7 order¹), and end on Thursday, September 11, 2014.

On August 25, 2014, the Settling Devotional Claimants and Independent Producers Group, the remaining parties, jointly moved the Judges to modify the hearing schedule again to avoid anticipated costs and scheduling conflicts that the parties believed the modified hearing dates would have caused. *Joint Motion to Commence Direct and Rebuttal Hearing on Originally Scheduled Date* at 1. In light of the parties’ concerns, the Judges hereby amend the hearing schedule as follows:

The hearing **shall commence at 1 p.m. on September 2, 2014**. Subsequent hearing days shall be September 3, 4, and, if necessary, 8. Apart from September 2, each day’s session shall commence at 9:00 a.m.; each day’s session shall conclude at 4:30 p.m.

The Judges request that the parties present to the Judges at the commencement of the proceeding an agreed-upon order of presentation, which includes opening statements of no more than 20-minutes per side as well as closing arguments not to exceed one hour per side.
