I am writing to express the opinions of the staff and administration of WTUR, the online radio station of Taylor University in Upland, Indiana. We believe that the terms of the agreement negotiated by College Broadcasters Inc and SoundExchange which were published in the Federal Register on November 5, 2014 are positive for our station and for the industry as a whole. WTUR would be unable to meet more onerous record-keeping requirements and, without this settlement, would be forced to shut down. We believe our college broadcasters serve an important role in introducing our listening audiences to new talent. The agreement provides a reasonable basis for setting statutory terms and rates, and we sincerely hope that the rates can remain in place.
