As the university advisor to WRFL (the University of Kentucky's FCC-licensed, student-run radio station), I'm writing in support of the proposed regulations to formalize the Webcasting copyright royalty agreement negotiated by College Broadcasters, Inc. and Sound Exchange. These terms, published in the Federal Register on April 1, 2010, provide a reasonable basis for setting statutory terms and rates and I feel it's in our station's best interest to continue operating under their terms. Specifically, the ability to pay a fee in lieu of recordkeeping/reports of use is extremely helpful given the amount of resources and time the alternative method would require. It's important to us, as a Noncommercial Educational Webcaster, to be able to continue under the current agreement and I hope you agree.
