## Public STINET<sup>®</sup> Service

The Defense Technical Information Center (DTIC<sup>®</sup>) is *the* premier provider of Department of Defense (DoD) technical information. DTIC's **Scientific and Technical Information Network (STINET)** is one of DoD's largest repositories of scientific, research and engineering information currently available.

**Public STINET** is *free of charge* and available to the general public. It provides access to citations of public release documents that have been entered into DTIC's Technical Reports collection, as well as the electronic full-text of many of these documents.

### Public STINET Value Added Resources

- The **STINET MultiSearch** is a Web-based service designed to be the DoD community access portal to pertinent scientific and technical information over a wide range of sources. MultiSearch makes it possible to search up to 10 databases simultaneously. Federal agency sources include the Department of Energy, the Environmental Protection Agency, and the Food and Drug Administration.
- The Web-based version of the **Staff College Automated Military Periodical Index (SCAMPI)** is available to our customers through the cooperative efforts of the Joint Forces Staff College Library, the National Defense University Library, and DTIC. The collection includes citations from 1996 to present.
- **Technical Reports Automated Information List (TRAIL)** is a group of 25 subject-based *electronic mail lists* designed to inform individuals of DTIC's recently acquired public release technical reports in various subject areas of interest. - The **Air University Library's Index to Military Periodicals (AULIMP)** provides citations and abstracts to articles, news items, and editorials from military and aeronautical periodicals covering all branches of the military since 1988. Links to some full-text electronic journals are also available. This index is updated quarterly.
- Links to the full-text documents of conferences sponsored by the **National Defense Industrial Association (NDIA)** are available from 1999 to present. NDIA is a partnership between industry and government that facilitates growth, innovation, and technological advances for all facets of the defense industrial base. NDIA membership includes approximately 1,100 corporations and 27,000 individuals.
- The **Militarily Critical Technologies List (MCTL)** is a detailed compendium of public release information on technologies that the DoD assesses as critical to maintaining superior U.S. military capabilities.
