Registration for DTIC[®] Services

Why register to receive DTIC information?

- Users are required to register with DTIC to ensure the dissemination of sensitive data is not compromised.
- DTIC's collection includes information about research performed, sponsored and cosponsored by the Department of Defense (DoD) on a range of topics.
- This information carries security classifications up to the Secret level and is marked by the originating office to show how it should be distributed.
- Individuals registered with DTIC can access much more information than is available from our public Web site.

Who is eligible to receive DTIC services? (<http://www.dtic.mil/dtic/registration/>)

- DoD civilians, DoD contractors and active duty military (including National Guard and Reserves on active duty)
- Employees of U.S. federal government agencies and government contractors
- Certain university or college researchers
- Certain individuals associated with DoD small business programs, Historically Black Colleges and Universities, Hispanic Serving Institutions, Tribal Colleges and Universities, other Minority Institutions, Defense Experimental Program to Stimulate Competitive Research or University Research Initiative eligible institutions
