The National Institutes of Health (NIH) Library is the focal point for the exchange of biomedical and scientific information vital to the support of the research activities conducted at the National Institutes of Health. The library also provides information services and resources to several other agencies within the Department of Health & Human Services.

The tour will include a look at the history of the NIH Library (including the effects of the 2007 flood and the Library's renovation), an examination of the duties of an NIH Informationist, highlights of the instruction and bioinformatics programs, an overview of the technology sandbox seminar, a bioinformatics discussion, and a look at NIH's "Going Green" initiative, all in addition to a tour of the Library and the Green Terrace.
