-  **Aquatic Sciences and Fisheries Abstracts (ASFA):** This resource includes Conference Papers Index, Oceanic Abstracts, Sustainability Science Abstracts, Toxline, Water Resources Abstracts – by Cambridge Scientific Abstracts
-  **BioOne:** An easily-accessible search protocol to the full-text of 84 research journals on the biological, ecological and environmental sciences.
-  **ISI Web of Science:** Access to current and retrospective multidisciplinary information from approximately 8,700 of research journals in the world.
-  **Journal Citation Reports®** Journal Citation Reports—Science Edition allows you to evaluate and compare journals using citation data drawn from over 7,500 scholarly and technical journals from more than 3,300 publishers in over 60 countries.
-  **JSTOR:** The online archive to past issues of over 300 scholarly journals with continued additions
-  **LexisNexis®** LexisNexis® is a provider of comprehensive information and business solutions to professionals in a variety of areas—legal, risk management, corporate, government, law enforcement, accounting and academic.
-  **netLibrary:** Access to the full text of 300 books in information technology and related NOAA topics
-  **Wiley InterScience** More than half of Wiley's journals on **Wiley InterScience** are digitized back to Volume 1, Issue 1. When the initiative is completed, **Wiley InterScience** will be one of the largest archives of its kind with content dating back to 1799 and over 1.5 million articles of scientific and scholarly research.
