

Recommendations from Working Group 3 made at the IME ICC2 August 18th 2004

Working Group 3 – Seriality

Objective

Reach agreement on the standards and the identification of the part in which the rules differ from ISBD (CR) about what constitutes a change in a new work/expression that justifies a new record.

Report

The Working Group analyzed the document in view of Frankfurt recommendations and completely agreed with the general recommendations made and incorporated in the December 19, 2003 version.

Because of the nature of serial publications, the Group acknowledges the importance of principles 6.1 and 6.2 about the creation of authority records for access points.

Recommendations towards a new cataloguing code

Report

The Group finds that there are not enough elements to make recommendations for changes for a new code at this moment, but proposes the following initiatives to create an environment for analysis and discussion of seriality issues in the region:

- The Group will stay in permanent session to generate specific proposals and recommendations
- Translation and diffusion of international standards related to seriality
- Expand the scope of the group to the professional associations and library science schools in the countries of the region.
