Biography

Carlton Morse (1901-1993) was born in Jennings, Louisiana in 1901, but later moved to Oregon where his parents owned a fruit and dairy ranch. He attended the University of California in Berkeley but never graduated, and his early career included working as a newspaper writer for the *Sacramento Union*, where he covered radio and police news. Later he moved to San Francisco, working for *The San Francisco Bulletin*. In September, 1929 Morse became part of the production staff for NBC station KGO, writing radio musical shows, mystery dramas, and serials. His well-known radio serial, *One Man's Family*, debuted in 1932 and ran until 1959, becoming one of the longest-running American radio soap operas. After he retired, he wrote six novels. He married twice, first in 1928 to Patricia De Ball, who died in 1984 and then to his second wife, Mildred. He died in 1993 at the age of 91.

Scope and Content Note

When *I Love a Mystery* debuted in 1939, Carlton E. Morse (1901 - 1993) was quite well known as the writer, director, and producer of the popular radio serial *One Man's Family*.

One Man's Family became one of the longest-running American radio soap operas, broadcasting 3,256 episodes from 1932 to 1959. *I Love a Mystery* which Morse also wrote, directed and produced, aired until 1952. Morse created other radio serials including *I Love Adventure*, *China Town Squad*, *Adventures by Morse*, *Family Skeleton*, and *His Honor, the Barber*.

The Carlton E. Morse Copyright Script Collection spans the years 1939 to 1952. It consists of one series, Scripts, which include forty-seven *I Love a Mystery* scripts (1939-1944, 1949-1952), four *Adventures by Morse* scripts (1944) and thirteen *I Love Adventure* scripts (1948), for a total of sixty-four scripts. The collection is arranged by program title, and then chronologically by year and by story number.

Series Description

Series I: Scripts - *I Love a Mystery*, *Adventures by Morse*, *I Love Adventure*

I Love a Mystery - (1939-1944), (1949-1952) - 4.0 linear ft.

I Love a Mystery was the story of three adventurers, Jack Packard, Doc Long and Reggie Yorke wandering the world solving cases for the A-1 Detective Agency. *I Love a Mystery* first aired on the NBC West Coast network as a daily 15-minute serial. In October, 1939, it became sponsored by Fleishmann's Yeast and was broadcast nationally. In 1940, it became a 30-minute weekly program airing Monday evenings on NBC's Blue Network. In 1943 the show changed

back to a 15- minute serial for CBS and was sponsored by Proctor and Gamble until 1944 when it left the air for five years. In 1949 *I Love a Mystery* was back on the Mutual network as a 15- minute serial, broadcasting week nights from New York. It ran until 1952.

The cast included Michael Raffetto, Barton Yarborough, Walter Paterson, and Gloria Blondell as the lead performers during the West Coast run from 1939 to 1944. In New York, Jim Boles, Russell Thorson, Tony Randall, and Mercedes McCambride performed reruns of previous scripts from 1949 until 1952.

Adventures by Morse - (1944) - 6 folders

Adventures by Morse was a 52-week run of mysteries written by Carlton E. Morse after his series *I Love a Mystery* was cancelled by NBC. It broadcast as a transcribed syndication from 1944 to 1945 in 30-minute weekly episodes. The series was divided into major stories which ran for ten weeks followed by a three-week story line. The show recounted the adventures of Captain Bart Friday, a San Francisco detective, and his assistant, Skip Turner.

Elliott Lewis, David Ellis and Russell Thorson alternately played the role of Captain Friday while Jack Edwards played Skip Turner.

I Love Adventure - (1948) - 3 folders

I Love Adventure, also written and directed by Carlton Morse, continued the story of Jack, Doc and Reggie. It was broadcast in 13 episodes as a 30-minute serial on ABC in 1948 on Sundays from April 25 to July 18. Actors Michael Raffetto and Barton Yarborough played their original roles as Jack and Doc, and Tom Collins played Reggie.

Administrative Information

The Carlton E. Morse Copyright Script Collection was registered and deposited for copyright at the Library of Congress in 1990 and 1991 by the Morse Family Trust. It is housed in the Recorded Sound Section of the Motion Picture, Broadcasting and Recorded Sound Division, Library of Congress. The collection consists of forty-seven *I Love a Mystery* scripts (1939-1944, 1949-1952), four *Adventures by Morse (1944)* scripts and thirteen *I Love Adventure (1948)* scripts for a total of 64 scripts in 105 folders.
