My darling Junie-

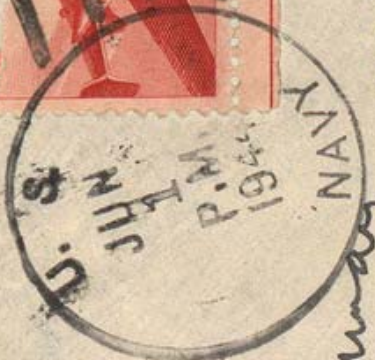
