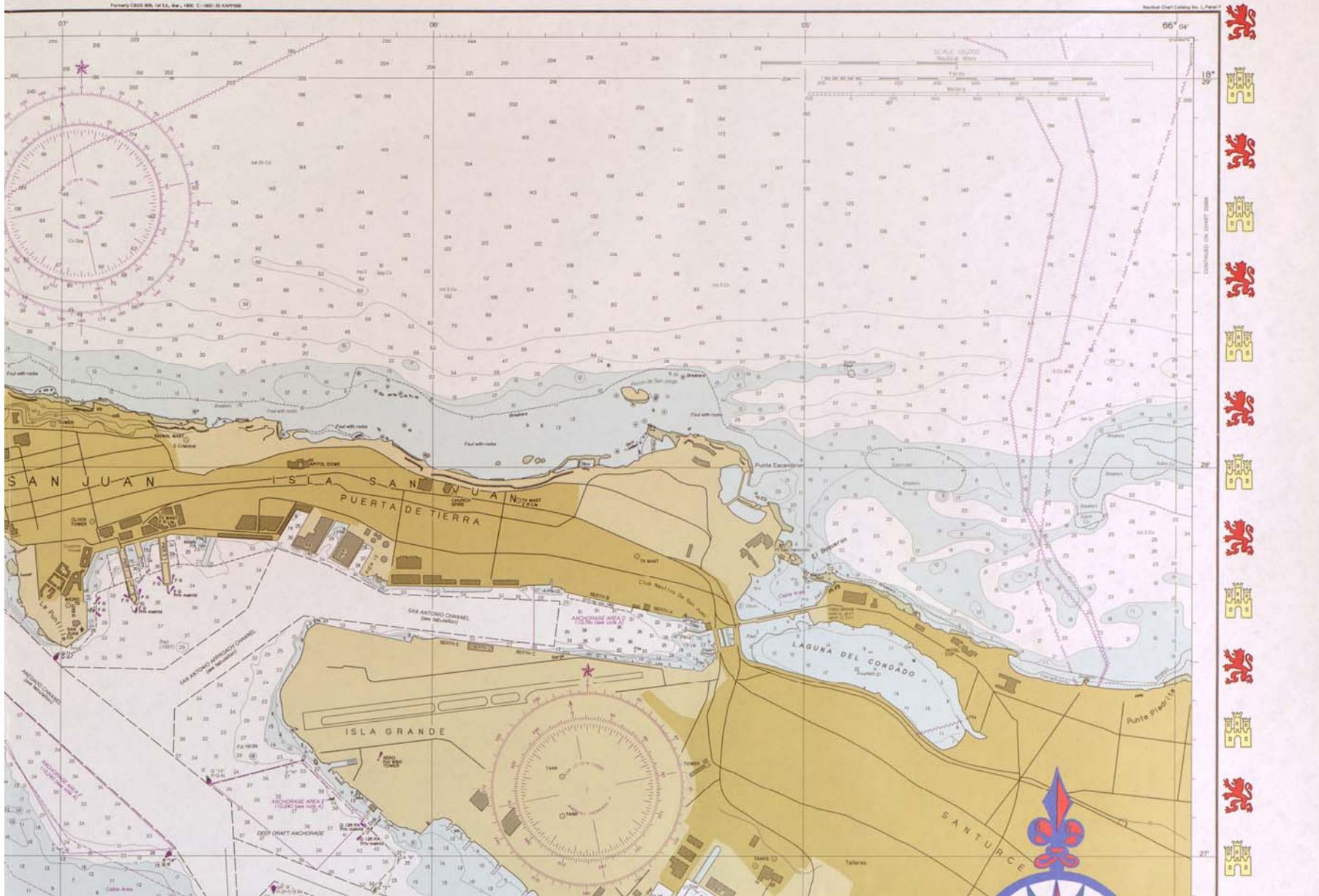

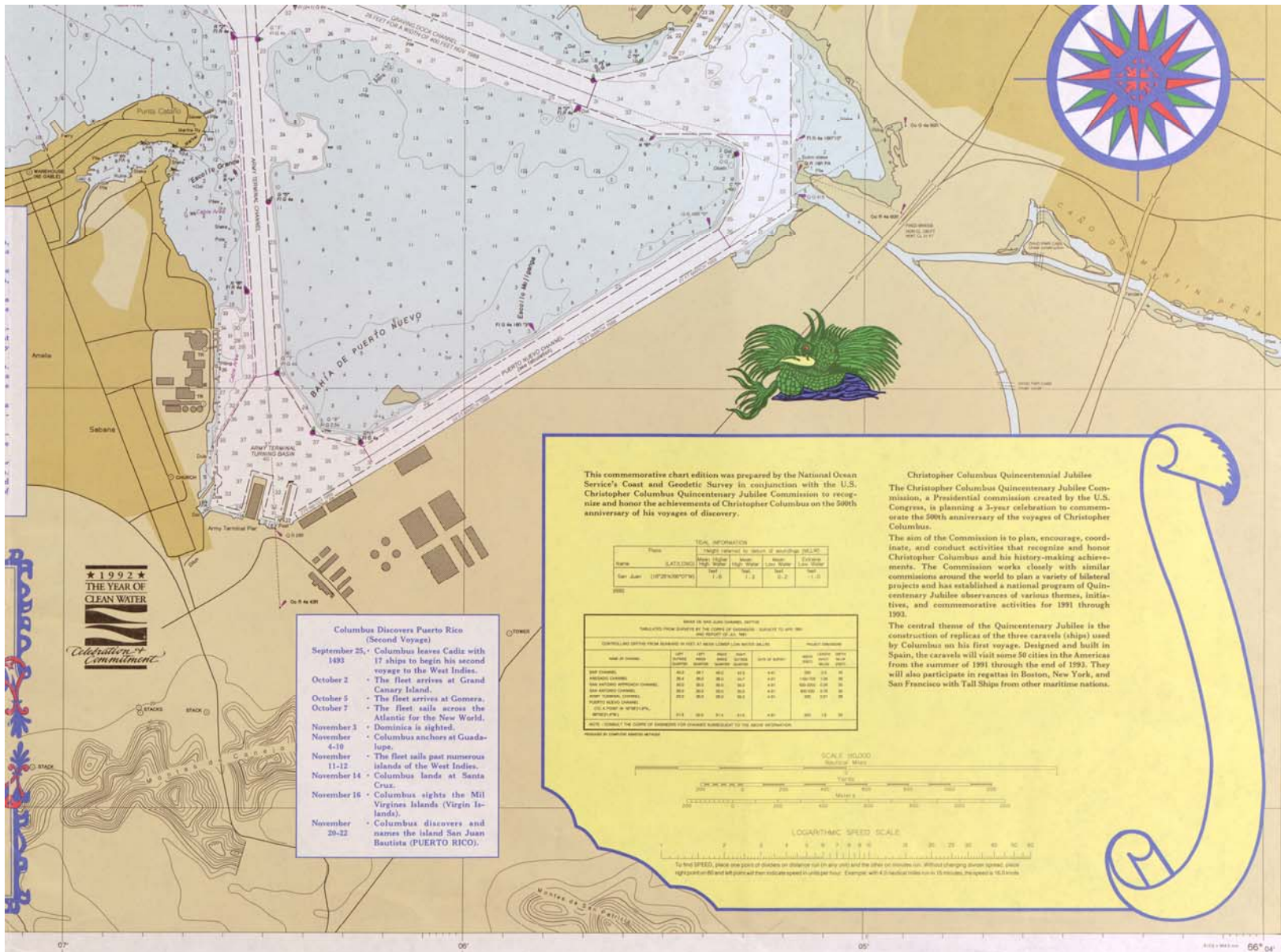

Columbus Discovers Puerto Rico (Second Voyage)

- September 25, 1493 - Columbus leaves Cadiz with 17 ships to begin his second voyage to the West Indies.
- October 2 - The fleet arrives at Grand Canary Island.
- October 5 - The fleet arrives at Gomera.
- October 7 - The fleet sails across the Atlantic for the New World.
- November 3 - Dominica is sighted.
- November 4-10 - Columbus anchors at Guadalupe.
- November 11-12 - The fleet sails past numerous islands of the West Indies.
- November 14 - Columbus lands at Santa Cruz.
- November 16 - Columbus sights the Mil Virgenes islands (Virgin Islands).
- November 20-22 - Columbus discovers and names the island San Juan Bautista (PUERTO RICO).

Christopher Columbus Quincentenary Jubilee

The Christopher Columbus Quincentenary Jubilee Commission, a Presidential commission created by the U.S. Congress, is planning a 3-year celebration to commemorate the 500th anniversary of the voyages of Christopher Columbus.

The aim of the Commission is to plan, encourage, coordinate, and conduct activities that recognize and honor Christopher Columbus and his history-making achievements. The Commission works closely with similar commissions around the world to plan a variety of bilateral projects and has established a national program of Quincentenary Jubilee observances of various themes, initiatives, and commemorative activities for 1991 through 1993.

The central theme of the Quincentenary Jubilee is the construction of replicas of the three caravels (ships) used by Columbus on his first voyage. Designed and built in Spain, the caravels will visit some 50 cities in the Americas from the summer of 1991 through the end of 1993. They will also participate in regattas in Boston, New York, and San Francisco with Tall Ships from other maritime nations.
