

Classical and Ancient Works H 1412

BACKGROUND: *This instruction sheet provides guidelines for assigning topical headings to classical and ancient works. Although pre-1950 Library of Congress cataloging reflects a policy of not assigning topical headings to these works, that policy is no longer followed.*

1. Topical works. Assign topical headings to any ancient work, original text or translation, that has a topical orientation. *Example:*

Title: Aristotle's Politics.

[a translation of the work by Aristotle]

650 #0 \$a Political science \$v Early works to 1800.

2. Works of belles lettres. Assign a literary form heading to any individual work of belles lettres, original text or translation, on an identifiable topic. *Example:*

650 #0 \$a Oedipus (Greek mythology) \$v Drama.
