

## Inspection H 1676.5

**BACKGROUND:** This instruction sheet provides guidelines for assigning the free-floating subdivision **-Inspection** and for using phrase headings for particular types of inspection.

**1. Merchandise and products.** Use the free-floating subdivision **-Inspection** (*May Subd Geog*) under types of merchandise and products for works on methods of examining them to determine their fitness for marketing. *Example:*

650 #0 \$a Lumber \$x Inspection.

**2. Machines, engineering structures, and types of buildings.** Use the free-floating subdivision **-Inspection** (*May Subd Geog*) under types of machines, engineering structures, and buildings for works on methods and procedures for determining compliance with safety regulations. *Example:*

650 #0 \$a Automobiles \$x Inspection \$z Virginia.

**3. Plants and animals.** Use the free-floating subdivision **-Inspection** (*May Subd Geog*) under individual and groups of plants and domestic animals for works on procedures for examining them to determine the presence of diseases or pests. *Examples:*

650 #0 \$a Cattle \$x Inspection.  
650 #0 \$a Corn \$x Inspection.  
650 #0 \$a Poultry \$x Inspection.

**4. Military services.** Assign the free-floating subdivision **-Inspection** under names of individual military services for works on official examinations of the service to determine and report on its state of readiness for duty. *Example:*

610 10 \$a United States. \$b Army \$x Inspection.

**5. Phrase headings.** Do not use the free-floating subdivision **-Inspection** under topics if a phrase heading for the concept has already been established. *Examples:*

150 ## \$a Factory inspection  
150 ## \$a Mine inspection

When assigning phrase headings of this type, verify that a 450 field of the type [*topic*]-**Inspection** appears in the authority record. Make such a reference, if it does not already exist.
