New Subclass KVJ

Subclass KVJ, Law of Hawaii (to 1900), is a new subclass of Law that has been developed at the Library of Congress. The subclass KVJ appears in Classification Web and is approved for use.

Subclass KVJ covers the indigenous law of the pre-Kingdom period (to 1810), the period of the Kingdom of Hawai'i (1810-1893), including overthrow of the monarchy and Provisional Government (1893-1894), and the Republic of Hawai'i (1894-1900), including the Transitional Government (1894-1900).
