- The rules of application of Urdu are to be used for Sindhi. Vocalization are those used for entry in Mewaram's *A Sindhi English Dictionary* (1st ed., Hyderabad, 1910), *Sindhi-Urdū Lughāt* (Haidarābād, 1959), and *Jāmi'-ī Sindhi-Lughāt* (Karāci, 1931).
