Summary: "This Civil War record is a copy of one writ[t]en during 3 years service in Co. K, 9th Vt. Inft. by Nelson L. Wandell who enlisted in Brattleboro, Vt., June 4th, 1862, and was mustered out at the same time and place, Burlington, Vt. This nar[r]ative gives the time and place of every movement made by the 9th Vt. during its 3 years of service. This copy was made by the above Nelson L. Wandell who has been a resident of San Francisco for 32 years. Copied while visiting Buffalo, N.Y., during the summer of 1906."
