


## COPYRIGHT ROYALTY JUDGES

### SUPPLEMENTAL DISTRIBUTION ORDER

Prior to the Copyright Royalty and Distribution Reform Act of 2004, the Library of Congress conducted distribution proceedings in the royalty rate funds for cable, DART and satellite. In a number of proceedings, final determinations have been published and subsequently royalties have been received by the Copyright Office and are available for distribution. The Copyright Royalty Judges find that no additional distribution orders are needed and that final distributions control royalties subsequently received.

Wherefore, **IT IS ORDERED** that in all distribution proceedings in which there is a final determination for distribution, the Copyright Office is authorized and **DIRECTED** to distribute all available funds pursuant to the final determination, including royalties received subsequent to the effective date of the final determination. This Order only applies to any proceeding in which a final determination has been entered. At present, the Copyright Office records show this status applies to 1993-1997 cable royalty fees, 1993-2001 DART royalty fees and 1994-1998 satellite royalty fees (there are funds available for distribution only in 1994-1995).
