

ORDER REGARDING HEARING SCHEDULE

The Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) have reevaluated the hearing requirements for the captioned proceeding and have determined that the parties can fully and fairly present all relevant evidence and argument of counsel in four hearing days.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Judges **ORDER** that the unified direct and rebuttal hearing in this proceeding shall commence on **MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2014**, instead of the earlier date set by prior order and end on **THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2014**. The first day of the hearing shall begin at 9:30 a.m. and end at 4:30 p.m. Each succeeding day shall begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 4:30 p.m. In their planning, counsel shall allow for one 15-minute morning recess, one 15-minute afternoon recess, and a one-hour recess at noon.

The Judges **FURTHER ORDER** that the parties shall confer and, on or before September 2, 2014, present an agreement regarding order of presentation. The agreed presentation may include an opening statement, not to exceed 20 minutes per side, and shall include closing argument, not to exceed one hour per side.
