**ORDER OF CONSOLIDATION AND AMENDED CASE SCHEDULE**

**Consolidation**

The captioned distribution proceedings involve retransmission royalties remaining on deposit for both cable and satellite retransmissions. The participants in the proceedings are the same. The issues for determination are the same. The schedules of case events are the same.

In the interest of efficiency of case management (as well as environmental preservation), therefore, the Judges hereby consolidate administratively the two proceedings for all purposes. All filings in the consolidated proceeding shall bear the caption illustrated at the top of this Order. If participants file papers pertinent to only one of the proceedings, they shall do so under the joint caption, but shall indicate the subject pertinent proceeding, as "Cable" or "Satellite," as appropriate, in the title of the paper.


Hereafter, the Judges will consolidate the docket for these proceedings, recording filings and orders only under Docket No. 2012-6 CRB CD 2004-09.

**Case Schedule**

By order dated July 23, 2014, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) suspended the case schedule issued on September 23, 2013. The Judges hereby issue an amended case schedule to adjust deadlines for certain pre-hearing case events. The Judges order these schedule adjustments to assure that the parties to the two captioned proceedings have an adequate opportunity to perform necessary pre-hearing tasks, to prepare themselves for and engage in meaningful settlement discussions, and to organize witnesses and evidence to further efficient presentation at the hearings.

Each party to the two captioned proceedings shall adhere to the schedule attached to this Order as "Exhibit A" until that party has documented a full and final settlement of all issues or the Judges have ordered the party's dismissal. The attached Amended Schedule shall remain in effect absent a further order.
