Report on federal library titles that match titles in the HathiTrust

Malpas' analysis presents a high-level view of the number of titles in federal libraries that have been digitized and made available through the HathiTrust. The [HathiTrust Digital Library](#) contains digital surrogates for 5.7 million titles linked to more than 10 million volumes. A large portion of this material, 2.9 million volumes, is available in the public domain. The public domain material can be viewed freely by any user. The digitized material in the HathiTrust comes from its 60+ member institutions.
