Since June 2003, the Federal CIO Council's Interagency Committee on Government Information (ICGI) has been working on how to implement Section 207 of the E-Government Act of 2002. The goal of the E-Government Act is to make it easier for all Americans to find and use government information and services through improved accessibility, usability and preservation. **See the event agenda below.**
