March 19 topics focus on technical requirements and specifications for digitization of specific collections:

- Audio-Visual Materials (11:30am-1:00pm ET)

Instructors for the modules are from the Northeast Document Conservation Center (NEDCC), a non-profit conservation center that provides conservation, preservation, digital imaging, and audio reformatting services to cultural heritage clients nationwide.
