The following is the policy of The Walt Disney Company on film preservation:

The company has conducted, and continues to conduct, preservation efforts for all titles owned by The Walt Disney Company. Black and white separation masters exist for all theatrical films, and continue to be made as protection elements on current feature productions. With the exception of 13 titles, all original nitrate film elements have been copied onto safety film. The remaining 13 nitrate titles are due for completion September 1, 1993. Vault conditions exceed the generally accepted industry standards and appropriate elements are geographically separated.
