Objectives

To show through a series of pictures, the abundance of fuel and power reserves available to the war effort by the coal industry.

Pictures wanted

1. Coal in the vein *vein*
2. Mining coal, undercutting, drilling, ~~after the blast!~~
3. Loading the coal into "trips"
4. String of loaded trips going out of mine.
5. Loaded trips coming out of shaft or mine mouth to the Tipple.
6. ~~Winch in the tippie,~~ machinery used in lifting cage etc.
7. The breaker, series of pix. covering the process of washing and grading coal.
8. Coal leaving breaker from various "grade" shoots, into coal cars.
9. Lines of waiting "empties"
10. Lines of loaded cars shunting from mine.
