Toner Excerpts

Overview

The Joseph Meredith Toner newspaper clippings collection includes clippings covering a wide variety of subjects including art, biography, business, civic functions, education, government, history, law, medicine, places of interest, recreation, religion, and science. The collection, while overwhelming from newspapers, also includes clippings from magazines, encyclopedias, etc. The clippings range in date from 1816 through 1895 with a concentration of items from 1833 through 1895. The vast majority of the clippings come from the Evening Star (Washington, DC), the National Intelligencer (Washington, DC), the National Republican (Washington, DC), and the Washington Post (Washington, DC). Nearly 800 of the clippings come from these four newspapers though there are a total of 138 newspapers represented in the collection.

Over the course of several years, beginning in 1882, Joseph Meredith Toner (1825-1896) donated his large research collection to the Library of Congress. Among the numerous items in the collection were files of newspaper clippings. These clippings had been individually mounted and separately bound. These newspaper (and magazine, etc.) clippings have since been gathered randomly into 39 cases of anywhere between 11 and 36 clippings per case and arranged by case and item number.

The finding aid for this collection includes information on each clipping's case and item number and, so far as it can be determined, the author of the article, the title of the article, the location of the newspaper (or magazine, etc.), the title of the newspaper (or magazine, etc.), the date of the article, whether illustrations are present, the genre of the article, and the general subject. The titles of the source newspapers, the date of publication and the city of publication from which the clippings in this collection are taken were, in most cases, indicated at the time these articles were cut out either by penciled inscriptions or by mounting the relevant information from the article. In many instances, the penciled inscription is unclear or smudged, or the mounted newspaper title is incomplete. When a likely transcription was possible, it was given. Uncertain transcriptions are given with question marks. When the inscription was completely illegible or indiscernible, no transcription was made and that data was left blank.

Organization

Location: The clippings in this collection were, in most cases, cut from newspapers. The cities in which these newspapers were published are indicated in the table in the "Location" column by an abbreviated code, beginning with the commonly used abbreviation for the state, followed by, in most cases, a mnemonic abbreviation for the city. When the clipping is not an article from a newspaper or when the newspaper is not identified clearly, an uncertain location may be given (with an question mark) or the location information may simply be left blank.

The location and code information are listed below first by location, and then by

code.

Source: The names of the source newspapers from which nearly all of the clippings in this collection are taken were, in most cases, indicated at the time these articles were cut out either by penciled inscriptions or by mounting the title of the source (e.g. Washington Post) at the beginning of the article. The names of these newspapers are given in the table in the "Source" column by means of an abbreviated code (e.g. Washington Post=WP). Occasionally, the penciled inscription is unclear or the mounted newspaper title is incomplete. In these cases, the likely code will be given with a question

mark after it. In other cases, no source could be determined or a non-newspaper source was given or seemed apparent. In these cases, the source has either been left blank or a non-newspaper source or possible non-newspaper source may be given (e.g. Journal of the American Medical Association, encyclopedia, etc.).

The source and code information are listed below first by source, and then by code.
