EXACT LOCATION OF CANNERIES SHOWN ON AN UP-TO-DATE MAP.

The New York Commercial Gives the First Complete Presentation of the Ramifications of One of the Greatest Industries of the Pacific Coast. About Which Little Accurate Information Has Been Obtainable.

MANY NEW CONCERNS ARE REPRESENTED.

Pack for 1900 Smaller Than in the Preceding Year, but Larger Than in 1899--Indications of the Salmon Run Are Sometimes Misleading.

THE AREA OF THE COUNTRY COVERED IS ENORMOUS.

SEATTLE, April 25 (Special).—The salmon industry is one of the most important of the Pacific Coast, and it is steadily growing in extent year by year. With legislation governing the manner of fishing and the introduction of hatcheries in favored rivers and streams, there seems no reason to fear that the salmon will become extinct. Along the thousands of miles of Alaskan coast line are many excellent fishing locations yet unoccupied.

Cost canneries declare that there is nothing so uncertain as the salmon run, more years the catch being enormous, and the following season, with all conditions apparently favorable, the run will be greatly diminished and the output of the canneries correspondingly less. Last year there were many canneries established, but the total pack for the coast was much smaller than for 1899.

The accompanying map showing over 350 natural miles of direct Pacific coast line, gives the locations of canneries at present established and in operation. From San Francisco to Kuskokwim Bay, merely following the swing of the coast, the distance is about 3,500 natural miles. If the indentures of the coast—the bays, inlets, sounds and canals—were to be included in the measurement of this distance, the figure would have to be multiplied by about 10. The map is a fairly accurate one, and shows the general location of every salmon cannery, there being more than 300 in operation.

By reference to the appended list of canneries, which is carefully revised and corrected to date, every cannery location on the Pacific Coast can be easily found. The great area of country shown by this map cannot at first be realized. It is enough to say, however, that it is further from San Francisco to Kuskokwim, in Bering Sea, than it is from New York to San Francisco.

SALMON TRADE NOTES.

Fishermen at St. Helens, Ore., reported good catches of fish on the two opening days of the season. One boat came in on the 15th with 4114 of worth of fish.

A few stevedores are entering the Columbia River, but at this season of the year their quality is not considered good, and the seasonal trade for them is only 25 cents.

Correspondence from Oregon City, Ore., under date of April 15, says: Fifteen dressed pounds of salmon were shipped to Portland by rail this morning. These were caught in the Willamette and Chinook Rivers, respectively, since indicated. A stevedore from Portland also carried down a full boat this morning. Minor items of Pack Fish, shipped four boats, the probable weight being 1200 pounds. The catches were very satisfactory and the quality good.

The Pacific Steam Whaling Co.'s log steamer left Seattle about April 13 for Ketchikan, Alaska, on the Neahkah. Where the company is going as mentioned. Two more companies, similar in organization to the large one now located on the Neahkah, but of not quite so great capacity, are expected to start shortly for the new plants and had in less number small boats, which will be taken as far as the Neahkah or Ketchikan, where the latter will join the company fleet.
